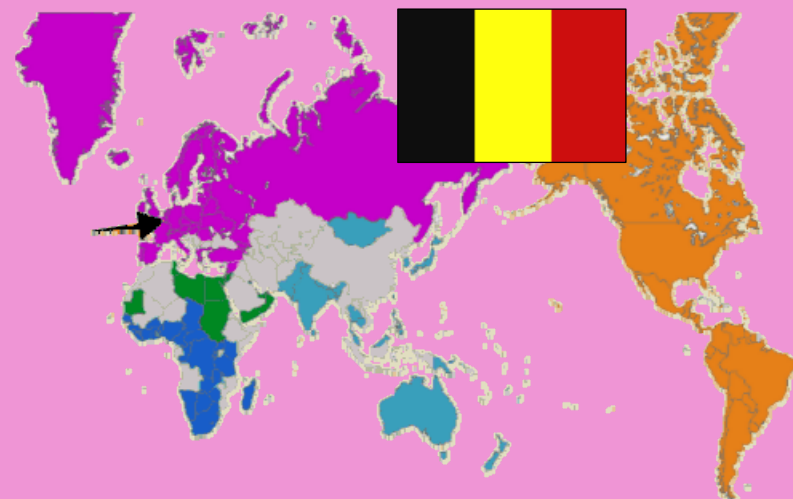

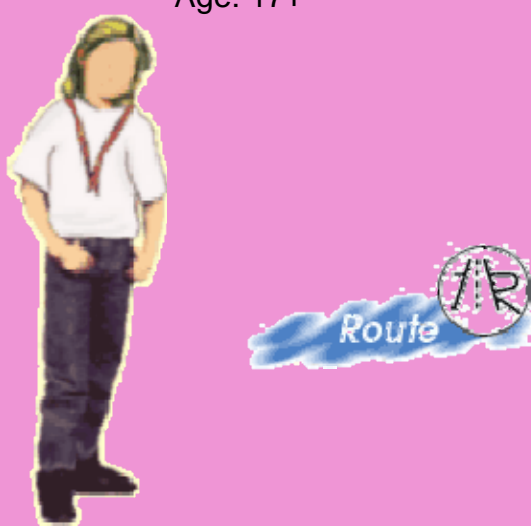

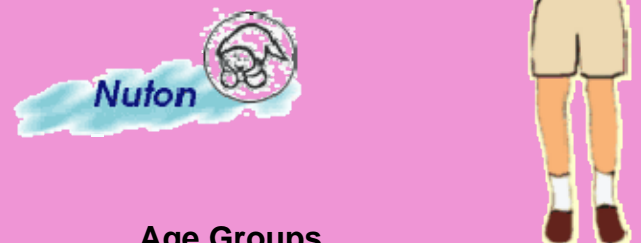

It is addressed to the young people, to girls or to boys from 15 to 17 years. The group that they constitute calls the Chain.

The link is the symbol of the place and the importance of each Horizon within the Chain. This link will be given as a sign of reception or particularly successful company.

The Horizon method is that of the project called "undertaken". It is based on the action. It will be born in the head from the Horizons and will be carried out in five stages: To choose - to prepare - to realize - to celebrate - to evaluate

Some aspects of the life Horizon

The Charter is a means which the Chain uses to express the reference marks which it is given to progress. The blue clover points out the colour symbolic system of the Branch Horizon. With the cross guides, it is the witness of the Commitment which it is proposed at each Horizon to undertake.

Engagement takes again the promise of guides but adds an additional dimension to it. Promising expresses what has direction for her and this towards what s he wants to direct her life. But it acts of a reciprocal engagement because the remainder of the Chain engages, like witness, to follow and support the Horizon to respect promise.
