Girlguiding Bermuda is a chapter of Girlguiding UK. Guiding of Bermuda is represented internationally by Girlguiding UK and the Chief Guide of UK is the Chief Guide of Bermuda. Guiding in Bermuda had been started long back in the 1930's have ever since grown enough to now boast 369 members. The program of Guiding Bermuda is a modified form of Guiding in the United Kingdom, adapted to suit local conditions. The promise of Bermuda Guiding remains the same. Rainbow, Brownie and Guide groups exist on the islands and Young Leaders are also active. In 2005, there were no registered Rangers of Guiding Bermuda. Bermudian Guiding has been honored by issuance of four commemorative stamps in 1969. The 30c stamp shows a young person abseiling and the 25c stamp depicts young people kayaking. Guides of Bermuda remember with pride and affection the visits of the founder of Scouting and Guiding, Robert Baden-Powell and the most important leader of Guiding, Olave Baden-Powell in 1930. Bermuda Girl guides were again honored by visits from Olave Baden-Powell in 1951 and 1954. Girlguiding Bermuda is now one of the most prestigious registered charities in Bermuda.
