- 5 A Girl Scout is courteous.
- 6 A Girl Scout is friendly to animals.
- 7 A Girl Scout obeys orders of her parents, Patrol Leader or her Guider without question.
- 8 A Girl Scout is cheerful and courageous in all difficulties.
- 9 A Girl Scout is thrifty.
- 10 A Girl Scout is clean in thought, word and deed.
